Colin toured with The Beatles and Rolling Stones among many others. He co-founded The End, today an iconic symbol of British psychedelia, their 1969 'INTROSPECTION' album, produced by Bill Wyman, now a collectors' item. Then publishing, A & R and record production, developing the next generation of talent. He was, indirectly, involved in the birth of music videos, having given a publishing deal to one half of Buggles, whose 'Video Killed The Radio Star' helped launch MTV. Next, TV drama, as a script editor and writer for the BBC and ITV. Now he has returned to performing, 'very low-key, but it reminds me why I first got into music.' Colin is cowriter of the Marc Bolan musical '20th Century Boy' which toured the UK nationally in 2014 and 2018.






