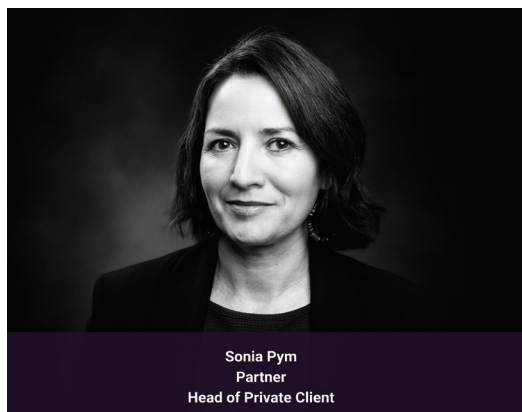
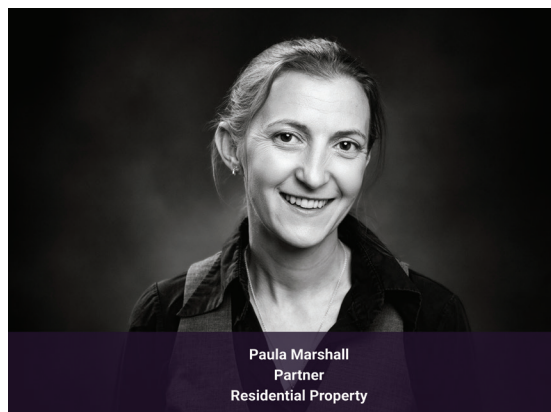
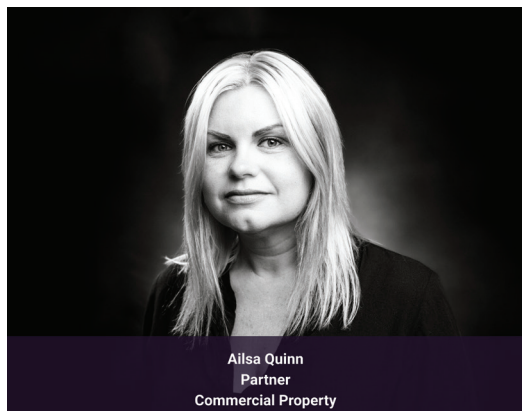

COLIN GIFFIN

Colin toured with The Beatles and Rolling Stones among many others. He co-founded The End, today an iconic symbol of British psychedelia, their 1969 'INTROSPECTION' album, produced by Bill Wyman, now a collectors' item. Then publishing, A & R and record production, developing the next generation of talent. He was, indirectly, involved in the birth of music videos, having given a publishing deal to one half of Buggles, whose 'Video Killed The Radio Star' helped launch MTV. Next, TV drama, as a script editor and writer for the BBC and ITV. Now he has returned to performing, 'very low-key, but it reminds me why I first got into music.' Colin is co-writer of the Marc Bolan musical '20th Century Boy' which toured the UK nationally in 2014 and 2018.

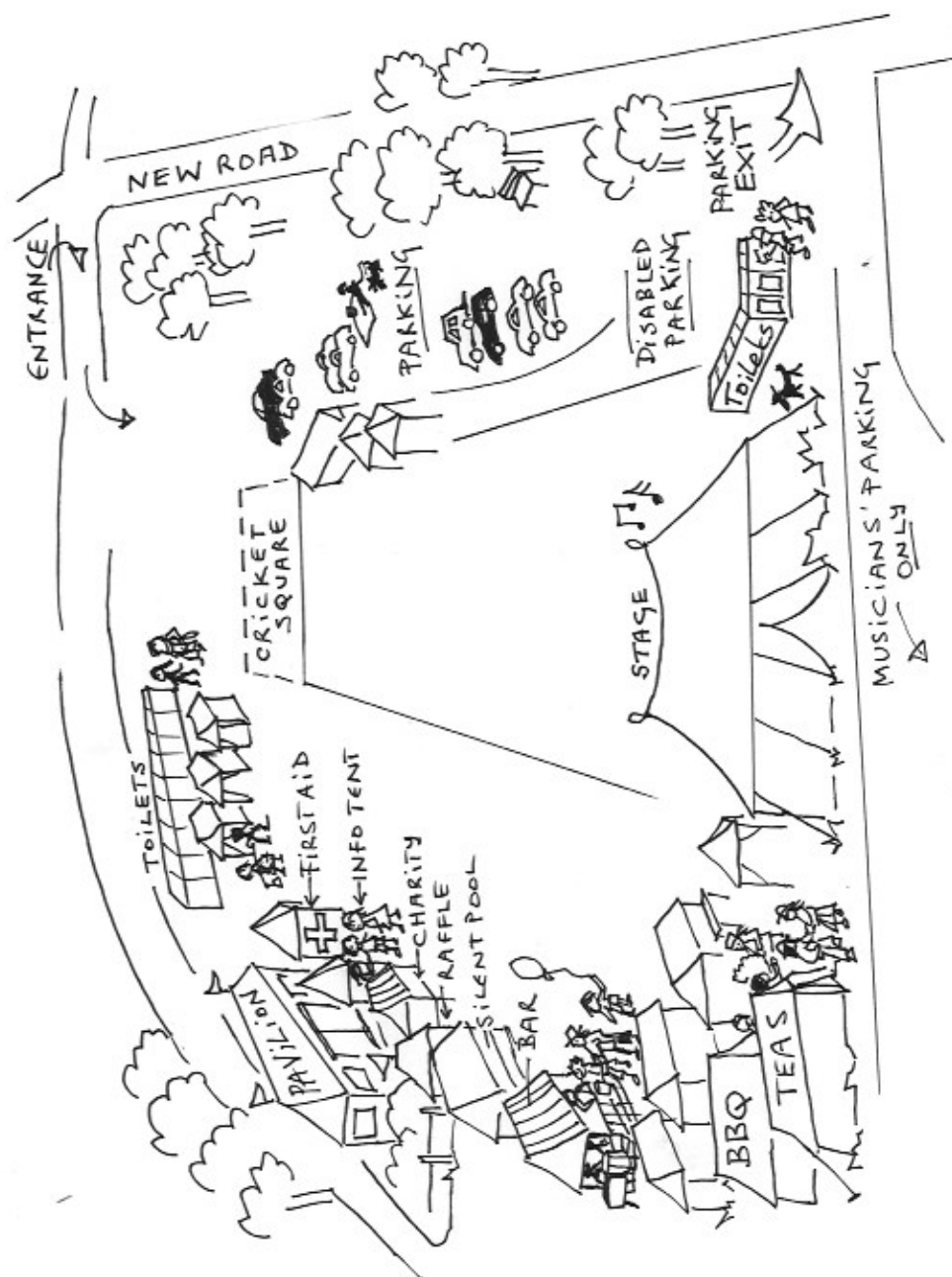

In 2021, he became a resident at The Boilerroom in Guildford, launching ROJAM and Friends Live, and later joined leading London agency SYCK Talent.

He's performed across the UK, sharing stages with Utah Saints, Charlotte Plank, and Stanton Warriors. ROJAM also hosts JAM Selects, a monthly show on Bloop London Radio spotlighting the best in house music.

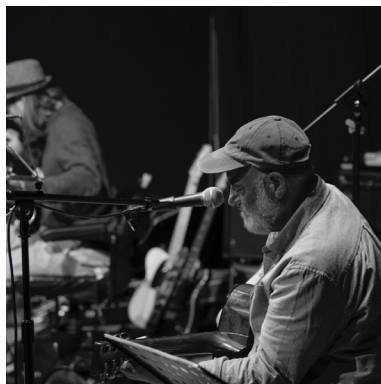

Easy going roots-country band Hickory-Ash were invited to BBC Television Centre to be filmed in the main studio by the 'Later With Jools Holland' team. Hickory-Ash songwriter Barney had previously recorded at BBC Maida Vale, also by their request, so they could test new studio technology. Next came a released album which was recorded here in the Surrey Hills not too far from Albury, in an old windmill in Winterfold - produced along with owner James and mixed by engineering royalty Robin Black whom also worked with artists such as Paul McCartney, Paul Weller & Pink Floyd.

Previously more regularly on the scene this home-grown Surrey Hills band decided to slow down shows to concentrate more on writing and recording, however Hickory Ash do perform at select gigs with great enjoyment!
